John D. Moore, CPP President

John D. Moore, CPP began his training career in Security Management, at Sembach AB, Germany. Beginning in 1966 he served in the Sembach AB 601st Security Police Squadron as a training NCO, conducting on the job training programs for all security personnel. Serving at Sembach AB was easily the most enjoyable experience possible in a brief 4 year USAF career, yet it translated into a future with constant evolutions in training, and security management experience.



Born in Tampa, Florida, John is the eldest of three sons of USAF Chief Master Sergeant Henry P Moore. Growing up in a variety of USAF bases and countries, he enlisted in the USAF, and was selected for Security Police training although John had selected every career field other than police. It is quite possible that the USAF knew more about him that originally thought, as John spent a total of 31 years in the Police career field, serving 27 years with the Spokane Police Department. John spent 16 years in the SPD Administrative Division, and researched commercial and financial armed robbery crimes, developing training programs and resources for armed robbery victims.
